

Young Artist Festival Virtual Performance Submissions & Winners Recital

Email video links and scanned music to <u>IsbillPiano@gmail.com</u> by midnight **Thursday, February 11**th.

- ♪ In the *subject line* of the email:
 - Student's or Ensemble's name
 - The student's competition ID number
 (Each contestant will receive a Master Schedule with individual entry ID numbers from IsbillPiano@gmail upon application submission. For example, SE3 designates Small Ensemble, 3rd entry.)
- ♪ In the *body* of the email:
 - The title of the piece(s) performed
 - YouTube link to the performance (See below on recording and uploading.)
 - Attach a scanned copy of the sheet music, .pdf format preferred, including the cover.

Recording Performances

Record your performance video in the spirit of a live audition or recital. You may record with or without an audience. Please dress as you would for a recital or live audition.

- ▶ You may get a better-quality video from a cell phone or iPad than a laptop.
- → Record an unedited video. Panning, zooming, or digitally altering will result in disqualification.
- ♪ Place camera in a fixed position.
- ♪ Show most of your body, as if you were on a stage.
- ♪ Introduce all selections at the beginning of the video:

"My Name is	My accompanist is	_ I will perform—
Titlefrom (if appropriate)Title of Work by—Composer"		

Accompanists

You may perform with a live pianist or recorded piano accompaniment.

Uploading Performances

- ▶ Go to YouTube and click "Sign in." Log in with your google account (Gmail) if you have one. If not, select "Create an account" and follow instructions.
- → Once your account is created, sign in and click the upload button (a little camera with a plus, labeled "create" when you hover over it).
- ▶ Upload your video. Once you initiate that, specify the following:
 - In the title, please include the student's or ensemble's name, and YAF assigned competition ID.
 - In the Description section include the title, larger work if applicable, and composer's full name.
 - When prompted, mark the video as "not intended for kids." This is a matter of whether it is distributed on the children's version of the YouTube app.
 - Don't do anything in the next tab "Video Elements." (May not appear when uploading from some devices.)
 - In the last tab "Visibility" select <u>Unlisted</u>, not private, or judges cannot see them.
 - Once you have finished uploading the video, YouTube will create a link.
 COPY the provided LINK and paste in submission email to: <u>IsbillPiano@gmail.com</u>
 - Please double check the links you provide for each video before submitting your performance.
 - Attach scanned music with numbered measures.

- ▶ Friday, February 19th you will receive an email from <u>IsbillPiano@gmail.com</u> with a link to the Winners Recital.
- → The winner's recital will premiere on YouTube 1:30 pm Saturday, February 20th. Please share this link with your friends & family.
- ♪ There will be a live chat window to share comments and encouragement.
- ♪ A link will remain on the YAF website for later viewing.
- ♪ Judges' written comments, winners' certificates and awards will be mailed to teachers following the recital.
